SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Pacific Coast Congress of Harbormasters and Port Managers (PCC) is offering a \$1,000.00 minimum academic scholarship to a qualified individual intending to enroll in a post secondary program in a marine related field. May include, but not limited to marine education, marine operations and development, marine sciences, marine engineering, marine recreation, marine repair OR to a qualified individual currently enrolled in such a program OR to a PCC member who wishes to take a University of Alaska Southeast training course.

The PCC offers this scholarship in memory of its past and long-time executive secretary, Barbara Schwantes. Ms. Schwantes was a true leader and promoter of marina and port development and was one of the key participants in promoting the PCC nearly thirty years ago.

The basic purpose of the PCC at all times is to serve the commercial fishing fleet and boating public. Among the organization's key objectives are the exchange of information on all aspects of harbor and marina operations, and the recommendation of policies to establish uniformity while promoting and encouraging the development of marinas and harbors in a sound and economic manner. The PCC prides itself on keeping all members of the congress informed of new developments and improvements through our periodic bulletin, "The RangeMarker".

Instructions accompany the application (see page 2). The deadline for submitting applications is May 3. The scholarship award will be announced no later than May 23. Applicants should keep in mind that they will be competing with students from the five membership regions mentioned above.
