THE FOUNDATION DIRECTORY

The Foundation Directory is the online database for the Foundation Center, an independent nonprofit information clearinghouse that collects, organizes, analyzes, and disseminates information on foundations, corporate giving, and related subjects.

- Detailed profiles of over 130,000 current U.S. foundations, corporate donors, and grantmaking public charities
- Over 3 million recent grants
- More than half a million trustee, officer, and donor names—fully indexed
- Program details and application guidelines for leading grantmakers

- Access funding information online, from any browser
- Gain access to a large keyword list, allowing for greater flexibility in your searches

Grant Databases

- **Foundation Directory Online**
The Foundation Center is an independent nonprofit information clearinghouse that collects, organizes, analyzes, and disseminates information on foundations, corporate giving, and related subjects. Select either "Grantmakers" or "Grants" to begin (our subscription does not include access to "Corporations") and use the extensive indexes. (restricted to use in the Library only; inquire at the Reference Desk, classes will be given extended access for a limited time period. Remember to LOG OUT)
- **SPIN Sponsored Programs Information Network**
"Over 40,000 opportunities from more than 10,000 global sponsors" - including Federal as well as private/foundation/corporation sources. In Basic Search use Keyword tab if your search terms don't work. Explore "Search Options" and consider including "opportunities that cannot be currently applied for" (restricted to campus users and authenticated HSU remote users)
- **Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance**
The CFDA is a compendium of Federal programs, projects, services, and activities that provide assistance or benefits to the American public. Although there are extensive dropdown menu choices using Advanced Search, it is also possible to search more simply. It can also be searched through Grants.gov: select Find Grant Opportunities and Apply for Grants.
- **Google**
Add the word 'grants' to your search. Organization websites often will have a category for Grants or Funding.


